

West Lakeview Neighbors Meeting Minutes Monday, Nov. 13th, 2017; 7:00pm; Butcher's Tap; 20 people present

Michael Sewall, board member, called the meeting to order at 7:05pm

44th Ward Alderman - Tom Tunney

Last week was the Public Safety meeting at the 19th District Police station. More cops will be added in 2018. Activity in process includes new lighting on Belmont, Henderson, Southport. With help of the Cubs and infrastructure money, this yr 5 blocks of new street lighting were installed. Private development - Whole Foods; Memory Care Facility on Ashland will have 140 apts with assisted living; Clark and Addison- 3 major sides at the intersection are under construction. More projects in WLVN will be coming next yr. Building at Southport and Belmont will come down for new development. Slowing housing market for single family houses has occurred. Moving forward on LV High School- new turf field, windows, cafeteria, tuck-pointing. Goal is to make LV the neighborhood choice for high schoolers. There will be open houses. 25 million for restructure of the high school. Things are good in the 44th.

Comment: Thanks for responding to call about rats.

A: We're putting a million dollars into that program. Looking at new methods, like dry ice, will start a pilot. Infrastructure causes upset to rat nests. More calls about dumpsters have been received since we all pay for pick up now.

Q Any info to residents concerning actions that people can take?

A: Feral cats have been brought in on several blocks. Dog owners don't always pick up after their dogs, that's a problem. Over the yrs people have asked about a dog park, but no one wants it near their house. The ward yard at Greenview will be sold and there are several things that could be done on that lot, the city wants \$800,000 for it. One reuse option has been a theatre company in such bldgs. One developer backed out already. The gardening community has increased dramatically. He tells people to come to WLVN for any rezoning. The water main project will be on Melrose and Henderson next yr.
